Regional average earnings per job are **\$14.4K below** the national average earnings of \$70.9K per job.

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- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 4.2%** since 2015, growing by 50,521. Population is expected to **increase by 2.8%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 35,664.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 3.4% in EAST Area from 554,982 to 573,609. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.1% by 0.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 55.5% to 59.2% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.6% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.4% below the national average), and **8.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




















Top Industry GRP




2020 Gross Regional Product








Top Occupation Earnings








